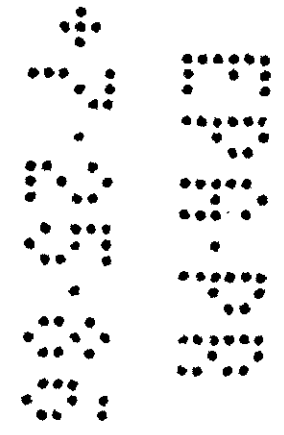

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to humans and domestic animals:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed

Environmental hazards: Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse clean with water and dispose of in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To control APHIDS, MITES, WHITEFLY and THRIPS spray thoroughly to wet all infested surfaces, or dip foliage portion of plant in spray solution taking care to avoid loss of soil. Repeat treatment at 7 to 10 day intervals.

Note: Store and use spray at room temperature. Protect blossoms, or rinse with water after treatment to avoid spotting. Do not allow excess spray solution or water to sit in center of plant. Keep plants out of direct sun while foliage is wet.

To control ROOT MEALYBUGS, be sure soil is moist, then pour ready to use spray solution evenly over the soil surface until drainage begins. Leave excess solution in watering saucer to be re-absorbed by the soil. Repeat in 7 to 10 days.
