PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazardous to humans:

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store at room temperature & protect from freezing. Do not reuse container or contaminate water or food by storage. Dispose of in trash collection.

USE CAUTIONS: Some plants are susceptible to injury from sulfur under certain climatic conditions. Do not use on Boston Fern, spinach, apricots, lilac, and viburnum. Do not apply when temperature exceeds 85°F. or in full sun. Do not apply for at least 4 weeks following application of oil spray or within 4 days of other pesticide applications.
RE-ENTRY: Avoid contact with plants until spray has dried.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Spray plants thoroughly to wet the upper and lower surfaces of foliage. Repeat as necessary for mildew control.
FLOWERS, FOLIAGE PLANTS AND ORNAMENTALS: Spray at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed to control powdery mildew, leaf spot, black spot, and rust.
ROSES: Spray at 7 to 10 day intervals to control powdery mildew, black spot, and rust. Be sure to treat new growth and buds.
FRUITS AND VEGETABLES: May be used up to day before harvest.
BEANS AND PEAS: to control powdery mildew. Spray at first sign of disease infestation, and repeat at 7 day intervals as necessary.
STRAWBERRIES: To control powdery mildew spray at first sign of infection and repeat at 3 week intervals. Do not apply to strawberry fruit that will be used for canning.
