WHERE TO USE: Apply wherever unwanted vegetation (weeds or grasses are) is present, such as driveways, along fences, sidewalks, patios, curbs, gutters and cracks in sidewalks. May also be used in and around vegetable gardens, however, do not spray directly on plants used for food.

Several (re-) treatments may be required to control certain deeprooted grasses and weeds such as Bermudagrass and St. Augustine grass. Top growth of these weeds (and grasses) will be controlled (killed) by each application, ultimately resulting in starvation and death of the roots.

This product has not been formulated to prevent germination of weed seeds, therefore, retreat (at two (2) to four (4) week intervals or) as required. Since the herbicidal effect of Sharpshooter® does not remain in the soil, treated areas can be (re-) seeded (sown) two days after treatment.

HOW TO APPLY: SHAKE WELL (BEFORE USE). Remove the cap from the applicator head making certain that the applicator head is screwed firmly onto the jug. Invert the jug holding it away from the body to avoid contact with skin or clothing. For best results, apply to weeds during early period of growth and during warm dry weather and treat the center growth of weeds. Herbicidal action is rapid with effects visible within hours. The speed at which SharpShooter® works is affected by climatic conditions. For fastest results, apply in warm, dry weather.


