
A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document, the product listed above is reregistered provided that you:

- 1) Amend the Confidential Statement as follows: The individual components on the CSF that make up the potassium salts of fatty acids (Emery 1202, Emery 659, and potassium hydroxide) should be listed on the CSF within brackets. The amounts of each should not be included in column 13.b. (percent by weight) or in columns 14.a. and 14.b. (upper/lower certified limits).
- 2) List the concentration of the active ingredient in nominal equal to that listed on the product label.
- 3) Identify each ingredient on the CSF by CAS Registry number or registration number.
- 4) Cite the chemical purity of the active ingredient in Column 10 of the CSF immediately after the chemical name.
- 5) Delete the sentence "Works in less than 8 hours!" from the label or submit efficacy data which support this statement.
- 6) Change the sentence "Kills Weeds and Grasses Within Hours" to "Kills Some Weeds and Grasses Within Hours."

7) The Precautionary Statements must state "CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

8) The Statement of Practical Treatment must read as follows:

"If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists."

9) The submitted label contains a statement of practical treatment concerning oral exposure. This statement is not required, based on the results of the acute toxicity studies; however, you may add the following statement of practical treatment for oral exposure if desired:

"If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting in, or give anything by mouth to, an unconscious or convulsing person."

This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.
