Kills Listed Insects on Ornamental Cherry, Spirea, Rose, Ornamental Crabapple, Maple, Andromeda, Oak and Taxus.

General: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Spray 12-18 inches from plant using a slow sweeping motion. Mist the plants lightly, including underside of foliage. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F. Stand upwind while spraying.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**Storage:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
