

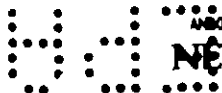

 For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Spray 12-18 inches from plant using a slow sweeping motion. Mist plants lightly, including underside of foliage. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperature exceed 90°F. Stand upwind while spraying.

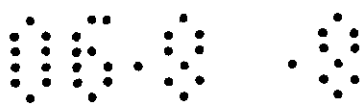
