

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray in all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings, and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Fleas: Spray sleeping quarters, bedding, floor and floor covering where pets are kept. Repeat as necessary. Use only a recommended spray on pets.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container and in a cool, dry locked area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

CAUTION

Do not apply over uncovered milk or food products. When using as a space spray, vent late area after treatment. In hospitals remove patients from rooms and allow room to ventilate 2 hours before returning them. Do not use in areas where fish or reptiles may be exposed to the spray.

When using this product in food processing plants, foods should be removed or covered before treatment. Any exposed utensils or food handling surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned before reuse. 
