

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USING.

Hold sprayer 12 to 18 inches from surface and spray to achieve thorough coverage. Use with caution on new, tender foliage. Do not use this product in or around electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

USE ON HOUSEPLANTS: To kill aphids, spider mites, red mites, mealybugs, thrips, scales, caterpillars and whiteflies. Apply when insects or their damage first appear. Spray to thoroughly moisten all plant surfaces where insects are feeding or resting. Repeat treatment every 7 to 10 days when insects are present as needed to prevent damage. **CAUTION:** Do not use on Crown of Thorns, jade plant or delicate ferns. Test on begonias, fuchsias and impatiens for varietal sensitivity.

USE ON ORNAMENTAL TREES AND SHRUBS: Including azaleas, begonias, asters, camelias, carnations, chrysanthemums and roses to kill aphids, leafhoppers, whiteflies, spider mites, red mites, mealybugs, thrips, scales, Japanese beetles, flea beetles, gypsy moth larvae, tent caterpillars, bagworms, leathers and other caterpillars. **CAUTION:** Do not use on Crown of Thorn, jade plant or delicate ferns. Test on begonias, fuchsias and impatiens for varietal sensitivity.

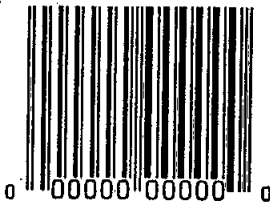
