Mix one part concentrate to twenty parts water or 1 FL. OZ. (10 TBS) PER GALLON OF WATER.

FRUIT AND NUTS: Use as directed above on apples, avocados, citrus (grapefruit, lemons, oranges, tangerines), peaches, nectarines, apricots, pears, almonds, pecans, walnuts, kiwi fruit, blackberries, logan berries, raspberries, strawberries and grapes to control JAPANESE BEETLES, FLEA BEETLES, WEEVIL ADULTS, CATERpillars (including NAVAL ORANGE WORM, BAGWORMS, LEAF TIERS, CODDLING MOTH and TENT CATERpillars), APHIDS, LEAFHOPPERS, PSYLLIDS, SCALE CRAWLERS, and SAWFLY LARVAE.
