To control fleas, ticks and lice on premises: Thoroughly spray infested areas including pet bedding, favored resting places, nearby cracks and crevices, along baseboards, moldings, localized areas of floorings and floor coverings. Place clean bedding in pet's quarters and launder or air dry sprayed bedding. Concurrent treatment of animals and premises will produce best results. Reapply every seven days to kill newly hatched individuals.
