The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is not acceptable for the reason given below.

1. The certified limits for the active ingredient pyrethrins are incorrect. The limits should be \pm 10% of the nominal concentration. Please refer to 40 CFR 158.175 for further information. If you wish to propose certified limits that differ from the standard calculation, you must submit an explanation of the basis of these proposed certified limits including how the certified limits were arrived at and its accuracy and precision. Please submit a revised CSF or an explanation of proposed limits as soon as possible.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
