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

HOUSEPLANTS: Use as directed above on houseplants to control (kill) APHIDS, CATERPILLARS, (SPIDER) (RED) MITES, MEALYBUGS, THRIPS, SCALES and WHITEFLY. Apply when insects or signs of damage are first sighted to thoroughly moisten all infested plant surfaces. Repeat treatment at 7 to 10 day intervals or as needed.
