DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read the entire label before using product.

IMPORTANT: SAFER® SHARPSHOOTER® IS A GENERAL CONTACT HERBICIDE AND WILL DAMAGE OR DESTROY ALL VEGETATION THAT IT CONTACTS. AVOID OVERSPRAY OR SPRAY DRIFT ONTO DESIRABLE LAWN GRASS, FLOWERS, SHRUBS OR TREES. KEEP PEOPLE AND PETS OFF TREATED AREAS UNTIL DRY TO AVOID PRODUCT TRANSFER TO DESIRABLE VEGETATION. SHAKE CONCENTRATE WELL, and dilute as indicated below for spot treatment of weeds. RATES: Young annual weeds (3-5 leaves)—Mix 1 part concentrate with 5 parts water (about 6.5 to 8 fl. oz. (13 to 16 teaspoons) per quart of water). Weed suppression or top kill of older annual or perennial weeds—Mix 1 part concentrate with 3 parts water (about 16 fl. oz. per quart of water). SHAKE DILUTED PRODUCT WELL. If leftover diluted product is allowed to stand for more than 30 minutes, shake sprayer before use.

USE: Use freshly diluted spray for spot treatment of weeds. Ensure thorough wetting (to the point of run-off) and complete coverage of all unwanted vegetation. Do not apply during windy conditions that will carry spray to desired vegetation. **Note:** only those plants or plant parts directly contacted by the herbicide spray will be damaged.

EQUIPMENT: The diluted product may be applied using any spray bottle, hand-held or knap-sack type sprayer which provides thorough wetting and complete coverage of vegetation. Ensure thorough mixing of diluted spray mixture. Do NOT apply using hose-end sprayers.

WEEDS: SHARPSHOOTER® will control most young, succulent, and actively growing weeds (less than 5" high). Several treatments may be necessary to control established weeds. Maturing (flowering), or woody weeds are less susceptible and may not be killed.

SHARPSHOOTER® may not kill all perennial weeds but will result in top kill and suppression. Weeds and grasses emerging after application, and regrowth from perennial weeds after top kill, will not be controlled without reapplication.

SHARPSHOOTER® is non-selective and non-permanent. For weeds in lawns and flower gardens, shield lawn grass and desired plants carefully to avoid damage. SHARPSHOOTER® will not move through soil to injure nearby plants. Treated areas can be sown two days after application.

REMARKS: Herbicidal action is rapid with effects visible within hours. For most rapid kill, apply in warm, dry weather.

May cause white coloring on some types of brickwork or concrete. Color will wear off after a few weeks.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
