Aviod spraying in eyes. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Cover or remove fishbowls. This product is not for use on humans.

Animals: Do not spray directly in/on eyes, mouth or genitalia of pets. Do not treat or cause exposure to kittens or puppies less than four weeks old.

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Housefäes, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Flies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs. Silver, isb, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Soubugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray when ever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Indian Meal Moths, Angoumois Grain Moths: Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application as necessary.

Exposed stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Tootbed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Granary Weevils, Grain Mites: Spray into cracks and crevices, ; around canons or containers or

other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, gardens and for spot treatments of incipier moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as pecessary. Allow to prevent spreading in large garden areas. All or all aprayed articles to dry thoroughly before used on plants, as well as a multi-put areas.

To control Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closers, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozile at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining. Allow all sprayed articles to dry staining.

thoroughly before use.

IN ANIMAL QUARTERS AND MILK ROOMS: For rapid control of House Flies, Mosquitoes, Gaets, Wasps, Hornets, Bees and Small-Flying Moths, close windows and doors and spray at the rate of 2 seconds per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

TO TREAT LIVESTOCK: To prosect beef caule, dairy caule, goats, sheep, hogs and horses from anacks of Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Face Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back, withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from Face Flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into eyes. Repeat treatment when flies are troublesome.

FOR SWINE: Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of last treatment.

To control Blood Sucking Lice: Apply to the infected areas of the animal, using a still brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

To control Poultry Lice, spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

For control of Bedbugs and Mites in poultry houses, spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and mites hide.

Fleas and Ticks: (Adults and Larvae): Remove and thor-oughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

To control Fleas, Ticks and Lice on dogs. Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Repeat application weekly if necessary to control infestations. NOTE: Not recommended for use on pupples less than four weeks old.

To kill Lice And Louse Eggs: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for three seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

FOR THE CONTROL OF GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese Beetles hit by spray, as well as Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafminers.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations
