c. On the bottom page of the label front panel, the net contents should be corrected from "5,6 fl. oz." to 5.6 fl. oz."

d. The data cited in MRID Number 43624301 for series 61-2 (Formulation Process) refers to the formulation for Evercide Intermediate 2460, EPA Reg. No. 1021-1556 which is the manufacturing-use product from which the pending product is formulated. The actual formulation process is required for the product submitted under EPA File Symbol 42697-UL.

e. Please provide the corrosion characteristics (Series 63-20) for the commercially packaged product.

f. Distinguish the commercial non-food\feed sites on the front panel i.e., "For Use in Apartments, Attics, Basements, Boats, Cabins, Campers, Closed Porches, Condominiums, Dormitories, Drive-Ins, Drugstores, Garages, Homes, Kennels, Kitchens, Office Buildings, Pet Grooming Parlors, Pet Sleeping Areas, Storage Areas, Verandas, Veterinaries, Zoos and the non-food/feed areas of Factories, Food Plants, Hospitals, Hotels, Institutions, Nursing Homes, Railroad Cars, Restaurants, Schools, Ships, Supermarkets, Theaters, Trailers, Trucks, and Warehouses."

g. Delete the instruction "Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured.", since this conflicts with the instruction Use one unit for each 6000 cubic feet of space. Also identify an average size room.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and warm water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by direct application or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

**To Kill Fleas and Ticks:** Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE:: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
