#### **GENERAL:**

Safer® Brand Insect Killer is a contact insecticide that provides rapid mortality of susceptible insects. Safer® Brand Insect Killer quickly penetrates the insect's body and disrupts the normal function of both cells and membranes. The net effect of this unique action is that the contents of the cells are lost and rapid death occurs. Safer® Brand Insect Killer is active only in the liquid state and only as a contact spray. No insecticidal activity should be expected once the solution has dried. As is common with most contact insecticides, Safer® Brand Insect Killer is effective on adult and immature stages of susceptible insects.

Safer® Brand Insect Killer is a pure soap consisting of 2.00% potassium salts of fatty acids manufactured by treating selected natural fatty acids with a potassium base. The other ingredients include a combination of water and alcohol, and contain no inorganic solvents.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL. To control Aphids, Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Mites, Plant Bugs, Psyllids, Sawfly Larvae, Soft Scales, and Whiteflies on ornamental plants, fruits and vegetables, spray as provided to thoroughly wet all plant surfaces. Apply when insects or first signs of their damage appear. For aphids or mealybugs, spray again after 2 or 3 days or when insects return. For mites and whiteflies, spray weekly. Be sure to spray undersides of leaves where insects feed and rest. For other pests, apply spray directly to the insect. Root mealybug and springtail infestations can be reduced using a soil drench of 6.5 Tablespoons (19.5 teaspoons) of Safer® Brand Insect Killer in a quart of warm water once a month.

SHAKE WELL. To control APHIDS, MEALYBUGS, WHITEFLIES, SOFT SCALES and MITES on houseplants, spray as provided to thoroughly wet all plant surfaces.
