
This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.

Apply 1 to 3 pints of 2,4-D AMINE 4 per acre on annual broadleaf weeds and up to 4 pints per acre on established perennial species. Apply to actively growing weeds. Do not graze meat animals on treated areas within 3 days before slaughter. Do not graze dairy animals on treated areas within 7 days after application. Do not cut treated grass for hay within 30 days after application.

Within 29 days following an application of this product, plant only those crops named as use sites on the 2,4-D AMINE 4 or other registered 2,4-D labels. Follow more specific limitations, if any, provided in the directions for individual crops. Labeled crops may be at risk for crop injury or loss when planted soon after application, especially in the first 14 days.

Under normal conditions, any crop may be planted without risk of injury if at least 90 days of soil temperatures above freezing have elapsed since application. When planting into treated areas, the risk of crop injury is less if lower rates of product were applied and conditions following application have included warm, moist soil conditions that favor rapid degradation of 2,4-D.
