

### Precautionary Statements

#### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Causes eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing particulate material or vapors and contact with eyes. Trifluralin may cause skin sensitization reactions in certain individuals. Use eye protection and protective clothing such as coveralls, a long-sleeved shirt, and gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

#### Statement of Practical Treatment

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation develops.

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation develops.

If inhaled: Remove individual to fresh air. If breathing difficulty occurs, get medical attention. If not breathing, provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation and call a physician.

#### Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product directly into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters. Obtain and comply with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge of effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. ### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, dry place. Store in original container. In case of leak or spill, contain material and dispose as waste.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Metal Drum Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Fiber Drum Disposal: Completely empty fiber drum by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into manufacturing equipment. Crush or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state or local authorities.
