PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Causes eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust or vapors and contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Technical trifluralin may cause skin sensitization in certain individuals. Use eye protection and protective clothing such as coveralls, a long-sleeved impermeable gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation develops.

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation develops.

If Inhaled: Remove individual to fresh air. If breathing difficulty occurs, get medical attention. If not breathing, provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation assistance (mouth-to-mouth) and call a physician.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish.
