Adjuvants or other spray additives (emulsifiers, surfactants, wetting agents, drift control agents, or penetrants) may be used for wetting, penetration, or drift control. Spray additives must be agriculturally approved if crops are to be harvested, grazed or foraged. If spray additives are used, read and follow all use recommendations and precautions on product label.

Refer to the WEEDS CONTROLLED sections of the Range Star™ label booklet for rate selection based on targeted weed or brush species. Some weed species will require tank mixes for adequate control.

Biennial and Perennial Broadleaf Weeds – Range Star™ may be used to suppress or control biennial and perennial broadleaf weeds in established grasses. Apply to actively growing weeds. Treat biennial

weeds when they are in the seedling to rosette stage and before flower stalks become apparent. Treat perennial weeds in the bud to bloom stage.
