Dear Mr. Gaskins:

The application referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable under FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(B), subject to the following conditions:

- 1. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration/registration/registration review of your product under FIFRA when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. You must submit an <u>analytical reference standard for quinclorac methyl ester</u> to the EPA National Pesticide Standard Repository by **07/01/2018**. Your failure to provide this in a timely or adequate manner may result in initiation of a cancellation action against your registrations.

Stamped copies of the labels are enclosed for your records. These labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product(s) for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell these products under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell the product(s) if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label(s), then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product(s) would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements

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EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If you fail to satisfy the data requirements, EPA will consider appropriate regulatory action including, among other things, cancellation under FIFRA section 6(e). - 2. Uses for which US EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and
- 3. Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with US EPA requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
