Dear Mr. Gaskins:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the following changes are made:

- 1. Put the FIRST AID instructions in a box to set them off from the rest of the label.
- 2. Under the header **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** on page 2 change the first sentence to read "This pesticide is toxic to mammals, fish and aquatic invertebrates."
- 3. In the list of Terrestrial Food Crops on page 2 change "Oats" to "Oats (seed treatment)" and revise "Leafy Brassica Greens" to "Brassica Leafy Greens Subgroup 5B"
- 4. On page 3 put the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** instructions in a box to set them off from the rest of the label.
- 5. On page 3 in the WARRANTY LIMITATIONS A DISCLAIMER in paragraph 1 change "In no case shall Albaugh, Inc. be liable for...under state law." To "To the extent consistent with applicable law, Albaugh, Inc. shall not be liable for consequential, special or indirect damages resulting from the use or handling of this product. To the extent consistent with applicable law, all such risks shall be assumed by the buyer."
