Dear Mr. Gaskins.

The Agency has received your application for an amendment, dated December 14, 2007. The supplemental label for the product described above, submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable, provided the following modifications are made:

- 1. The annual maximum application rate for all food/feed crops is 1.5 lb a.i/A, as required in the Oxyfluorfen RED (p. 63). The maximum rate your label allows for banded application to dormant tree fruit/nut/vine crops is 8 pints/A, which is equivalent to 2 lb a.i./A. You must revise the application rate to be in compliance with the maximum allowable rate of 1.5 lb a.i./A.
- Add the following statement to the label: "The use of any treated plants for feed 2. or forage, the feeding or grazing of any treated area, and application after buds start to swell or when foliage or fruit are present are prohibited."
