Dear Mr. Gaskins,

The Agency has received your application for an amendment, dated December 14, 2007. The supplemental label for the product described above, submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable, provided the following modifications are made:

1. The annual maximum application rate for all food/feed crops is 1.5 lb a.i./A, as required in the Oxyfluorfen RED (p. 63). The maximum rate your label allows for banded application to dormant tree fruit/nut/vine crops is 8 pints/A, which is equivalent to 2 lb a.i./A. You must revise the application rate to be in compliance with the maximum allowable rate of 1.5 lb a.i./A.
2. Add the following statement to the label: "The use of any treated plants for feed or forage, the feeding or grazing of any treated area, and application after buds start to swell or when foliage or fruit are present are prohibited."

Almond, Apple, Apricot, Avocado, Beechnut, Brazil Nut, Butternut, Cashew, Cherry, Chestnut, Chinquapin, Crab Apple, Date, Feijoa, Fig, Filbert, Grapes, Hickory Nut, Kiwi, Loquat, Macadamia Nut, Mayhaws, Nectarine, Olives, Peach, Pear, Pecan, Persimmon, Pistachio, Plum, Pomegranates, Prune, Quince, and Walnut.

DOSAGE -

- For pre-emergence control of susceptible weeds, 5 to 8 (1.25 to 2 lb active) pints for banded application.
- For post-emergence control apply 2 to 8 pints (0.5 to 2 lb active) per banded application.

Applications to weeds beyond this 4-inch stage may result in partial control.

SPRAY VOLUME -

Preemergence	20 or more
Postemergence (up to 4-inch or 4-leaf stage)	40 or more
Exceeding 4-inch or 4-leaf stage	100 or more

USE RESTRICTIONS -

For banded applications, do not apply more than 8 pints per acre (2 lb active) per use season within the treated band.
