  - b. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 42750-196"
  - c. Add the street address under "ALBAUGH, INC." at the bottom of page 1.
  - d. Put the FIRST AID instructions in a box to set them off from the rest of the text.
  - e. Add the following at the bottom of the **FIRST AID** box: "For emergency information, please call 1-800-XXX-XXXX." (Insert emergency phone number)

### WHEN TO USE

This product is highly effective when it is used to prevent diseases or applied at the first sign of disease. Start treating when grass begins to turn green in the spring or when signs of diseases are first noticed. For best disease control, treat every 2 weeks.

### RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply more than 13 treatments per year. In Nassau and Suffolk Counties in New York State, do not apply more than 3 times per given area per year.

Do not treat lawns during periods of stress, i.e. heat, drought, flooding, insects, excessive fertilizer, herbicides or pesticide use, etc.

### HOW TO USE

Determine the size of the area (lawn) to be treated. To calculate square feet, multiply length by width.

Start at the farthest point to be treated and work backward so you don't walk over treated area. Walk at a steady pace and spray using a side-to-side [arc] motion, slightly overlapping the treated area.

The entire [32 oz] bottle will treat 3,000 sq ft of lawn. Refer to [sight gauge] [Easy-View] [Clear-View] measuring window to guide coverage. When bottle is half empty, you should have covered half the area.

### **ENTIRE LAWN**

### HOSE END SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS [Dial Button]

- 1. Shake container well before using.
- 2. Connect a garden hose to the Ready Spray nozzle. Make sure the dial on the nozzle is in the "OFF" position with the [green] safety tab in the valve notch.
- 3. Turn on water at faucet. Extend hose to the farthest area to be treated and work back toward the faucet so you don't come in contact with the treated area.

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4. To BEGIN spraying, point nozzle toward lawn or plants to be treated and 1.) bend the [green] safety tab (located at right of [yellow] dial) back and hold, 2.) using your other hand, QUICKLY turn the dial clockwise until it stops and [green] tab engages into notch. Water will automatically mix with the product.

- 5. Spray lawn or plants thoroughly. Walk at a steady pate while spraying using an even sweeping motion, slightly overlapping treated areas. [One quart] [two quarts] [one gallon] will treat [3,000] [6,000] [12,000] sq ft. Calculate square feet by multiplying length by width. Refer to sight gauge to guide coverage (example: when bottle is half empty, you should have covered half the area).
- 6. To STOP spraying, QUICKLY turn the dial in the opposite direction of "ON" (counter clockwise) until it stops and the safety tab engages into the notch. Turn water off at faucet. To relieve pressure before removing nozzle from hose, bend the safety tab back and turn dial "ON" until water stops spraying.
- 7. To STORE unused product, make sure the dial is in the "OFF" position with the green safety tab in the valve notch. Place in a cool area away from heat, sunlight or open flame.

Rainproof— rain or watering 2 hours after application will not wash away effectiveness. [If rainfall occurs within 2 hours of application, the product should be reapplied.]
