 - 3. If in Eyes
 - 4. If Inhaled

5) On page 2:

- Change the signal word to "Warning".
- Revise the Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals section so that it reads as follows: "May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing tobacco or using the toilet. Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, and gloves. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear protective eyewear. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."
