  - a. Storage Stability (830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristics (830.6320) studies with observations made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 month intervals.
3. Make the following change to the label:
  - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 42750-225"
  - b. Increase the type size of the Signal Word "CAUTION" to comply with the sizing requirements in the EPA Label Review Manual.
  - c. Revise the "Container Disposal" section to comply with PR Notice 2007-4 regarding the missing non-refillable statements.
4. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label with the changes listed above for the record before the product is released for shipment.
