PRODUCT INFORMATION

ST PRE-MIX #11 is a seed treatment product that protects against certain early season insects, soil-borne and seed-borne diseases of crop plants. ST PRE-MIX #11 contains the active ingredients imidacloprid, metalaxyl, thiophanate-methyl, and fludioxonil.

Imidacloprid is a systemic seed treatment insecticide in the neonicitinoid class. Imidacloprid protects against listed chewing and sucking insect pests.

Metalaxyl is a fungicide which protects against *Pythium*, *Phytophthora* and systemic downy mildew. Thiophanate-methyl is a systemic fungicide which protects against *Fusarium* and *Rhizoctonia*.

Fludioxonil is a fungicide which protects against *Fusarium*, *Rhizoctonia*, and suppresses seed-borne *Sclerotinia* and *Phomopsis* spp.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Mix thoroughly before use or use entire container at one time.

TANK MIXING: All tank mixes should be pre-tested to determine physical compatibility between formulations. Follow the most restrictive precautions and limitations of all products used in mixtures. **DO NOT** tank mix with any product that contains a prohibition against tank mixing.

It is the pesticides user's responsibility to ensure that all products are registered for intended use. Read and follow the applicable restrictions and limitations and directions for use on all product labels involved in tank mixing. Users must follow the most restrictive directions and precautionary statements of each product in the mixture.

IMPORTANT: Always re-circulate ST PRE-MIX #11 thoroughly before using. The typical density of ST PRE-MIX #11 is 9.5 lbs per gallon. Consult the manufacturer of the application equipment you plan to use for suitability for this application and for instructions on operation and calibration of the equipment. Follow the manufacturer application instructions for the seed treatment equipment being used.

Apply ST PRE-MIX #11 as a water-based slurry utilizing standard slurry seed treatment equipment which provides uniform seed coverage. Uneven or incomplete seed coverage may not give the desired level of disease control. Thoroughly mix the specified amount of ST PRE-MIX #11 into the required amount of water or liquid inoculant for the slurry treater and dilution rate to be used.

Certain crops require addition of inoculants when the seed is treated or planted. ST PRE-MIX #11 is compatible with several liquid inoculant products. Consult the maker of the inoculant product and a Albaugh representative for directions before applying ST PRE-MIX #11 with inoculants.

Under certain disease conditions, additional amounts of fungicides may be required. When needed, apply additional metalaxyl or mefenoxam containing product and fludioxonil containing product according to the label **USE SPECIFICATIONS.** Other tank mix partners may be used with ST PRE-MIX #11; however, the user must consider the use rate, formulation, seed and crop safety factors and compatibility of each product to be mixed when determining the total application volume.

The total application volume must be sufficient to provide desired level of coverage. Dilution is typically done with water or liquid inoculants. The minimum slurry volume to achieve adequate coverage is 4.0 fluid ounces per 100 pounds of seed. More diluent may be required to obtain complete coverage.

Continuous agitation or mixing of the slurry mixture is necessary to prevent settling out of the solution.

Allow seed to dry before bagging.

Follow planter manufacture specifications for use of talc or other additives at planting. Seed must be completely dry before adding to planter.

ST PRE-MIX #11 contains an EPA approved dye/colorant that imparts an unnatural color to the seed as required by the Federal Seed Act.

ST PRE-MIX #11 also contains a polymer to improve the adherence of seed treatment components to the seed.

SEED BAG LABELING REQUIREMENTS

Seed commercially treated with this product must be labeled in accordance with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act. The user of this product is responsible for ensuring that the seed bag meets all requirements under the Federal Seed Act.

- **DO NOT** graze or feed livestock on treated areas for 45 days after planting.
- DO NOT apply a neonicitinoid insecticide within 45 days of planting seed treated with ST PRE-MIX #11.
- Exposed treated seed may be hazardous to birds and wildlife. Cover or incorporate spilled treated seeds. Excess or leftover seed may be double-sown around the headland or buried away from bodies of water in accordance with local requirements.

SPECIFIC CROP USE DIRECTIONS

TARGET INSECTS (All Uses)

Early season protection against injury by aphids, bean leaf beetle, grape colaspis, leaf miners, leaf hoppers, Mexican bean beetle, seed corn maggot, three-cornered alfalfa hopper, thrips, white grubs, and wireworm.

ST PRE-MIX #11 also protects against pea leaf weevil.

When treated according to the following directions for post-planting protection against listed pests, ST PRE-MIX #11 will also provide protection during post treatment storage of the seed against damage from the following stored grain insects: Indian Meal Moth (Plodia interpunctella), Rice Weevil (Sitophilus oryza), Red Flour Beetle (Tribolium castaneum), and Lesser Grain Borer (Rhizopertha dominica).

If seed to be treated has existing infestations of stored grain insects, fumigate the seed prior to treating with ST PRE-MIX #11 and bagging.

TARGET DISEASES (All Uses)

Protection against damping-off, seed, and seedling diseases due to Pythium, Phytophthora, Fusarium, and Rhizoctonia species. ST PRE-MIX #11 also suppresses seed-borne Sclerotinia and Phomopsis species.

The additional metalaxyl or mefenoxam product may reduce compatibility with some *rhizobia* inoculants. Consult with the maker of rhizobia inoculants before adding the additional metalaxyl or mefenoxam product.

RESTRICTIONS

- CA RESTRICTION: Seed and Pod Vegetables seed treated in California must be destined for planting in states other than California and is not to be planted in California.

IMPORTANT: To maintain mg ai / seed, adjust fluid ounces / 100 lbs. of seed in proportion to the actual seed count / lb. compared to the standard number of seeds / lb. for that crop; fluid ounces per number of seeds (i.e., 1000, 80,000,140,000) does not need to be adjusted. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities. Plastic containers are also disposable by incineration.

Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 psi for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.
