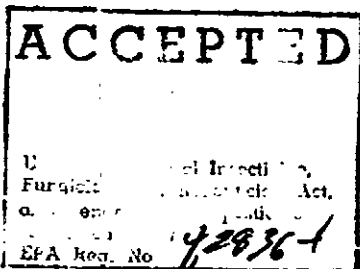

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

CAUTION: Inner packet is not to be opened until collar is ready to be put to use. The collar is intended to serve as an insecticide generator and is not to be taken internally by man or animals. It is possible that some animals may be sensitive to this collar. Observe neck area when collar is first worn to catch any signs of irritation or adverse reactions. If there are signs of irritation or adverse reactions, remove collar. Do not use on cats, whippets, greyhounds, or sick or convalescing dogs. Other pesticides are not necessary and therefore should not be used while collar is worn.

Do not allow children to play with this collar.

The insecticide in this collar is a cholinesterase inhibitor.

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS: Atropine is antidotal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this collar in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

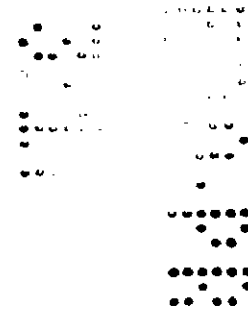
Securely buckle collar around dog's neck. To insure that the collar is not too tight, insert two or three fingers between collar and dog's neck while buckling. All excess length should be cut off, wrapped, and placed in trash. The collar will go into immediate action killing fleas present on the dog and any new fleas that may appear later. The collar will continue this action for the 3 months it is on your pet. Ticks are tough and therefore the collar will not kill them so readily. Usually, it takes 1-5 days to kill a tick and this potency will remain for only 8 weeks. For best results, hard-to-kill ticks inside ears should be removed when collar is put on and you should brush your pet to remove dead ticks that may remain in the dog's coat. When bathing dog, remove collar and return to neck only when dog is dry. This collar is to be worn with a regular collar and may be replaced when effectiveness diminishes.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty pouch or box. Wrap pouch or box and put in trash collection. When discarding used collar, wrap and place in trash.
