DIRECTIONS FOR USE it is a violation of Federal law to use this collar in a manner inconsistent with its tabeling. Place Freedom Five collar around the cot's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Cut off and dispose of excess length. The collar must be worn loosely so that two fingers can be placed between collar and cat's neck. If collar is worn too bythly, it may produce neck intration. Activity against fleas starts within 24 hours, reaches maximum effectiveness in 3-4 days and continues as long as the collar is worn (up to 150 days). Ticks are relatively harder to tall and die more slowly. Activity against tacks will occur within a few days and will continue talling and controlling ticks for up to 150 days. Fleas and ticks present in the animal's environment that may reappear on the cot will be folled and controlled by the action of the collar Replace collar when effectiveness diminishes. Collar is not affected by normal wetting such as rainfalt, however, it is suggested the collar be removed before bathing.

DISPOSAL. Do not reuse empty pouch or box. After fitting collar wrap pouch or box with excess collar put in trash can. When discarding used collar, wrap inside newspaper and place in trash collection.
