

This product is intended for indoor use only This product may be applied in

Single-Family and Multi-Family Residences

Public and Commercial Buildings such as hotels hospitals nursing homes daycare centers schools fitness centers and retail establishments

Food and Feed Handling Establishments which include places other than private residences in which food is held processed prepared and/or served

Non-Food Areas of Food Handling Establishments which include garbage rooms lavatories floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules offices locker rooms machine rooms boiler rooms garages mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling) and

Food Areas of Food Handling Establishments which include areas for receiving serving storage (dry cold frozen raw) packaging (canning bottling wrapping boxing) preparing (cleaning slicing cooking grinding) edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills dairies edible oils syrups)

When used in Food Handling Establishments apply as a crack and crevice treatment only

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Results Indoor Insect Killer is intended for application by hand using a bulbous duster a small broom or paint brush or other acceptable application method capable of directing insecticide to hiding and running areas and places where listed insect pests are found Applications with a power duster are prohibited Apply lightly and uniformly in treatment area The amount to be applied will vary with the site but should usually be 8 to 16 oz per 1 000 sq ft

Bed Bugs Apply to cracks-and crevices voids and/or harborages where evidence of bed bugs occurs including bed frames box springs inside empty dressers furniture and clothes closets carpet edges high and low wall moldings behind headboards pictures and wallpaper edges Only apply as a spot treatment to areas no greater than 3 feet by 3 feet per room Do not make surface applications to mattresses or bedding Mattress treatments must be limited to seams folds and edges only Do not treat pillows bedding or clothing Remove linens and wash before reuse Remove all cloth and other articles from dressers or clothes closets before application

Make a thin uniform barrier of Results Indoor Insect Killer between you and the bedbugs Continue sleeping in your bed to keep the bed bugs from moving to a new location or going into temporary hibernation Repeat treatment every 7 days for 4 to 6 weeks Female bed bugs typically lay 5 eggs per day and the eggs hatch every 8-10 days If a re-treatment is late additional treatments at 7-day intervals may be needed to break the bed bug life cycle

Cockroaches and Silverfish Dust lightly paying special attention to cracks and hidden surfaces around pipes sinks and moldings

Ants, Crickets and Box Elder Bugs Dust lightly areas around windows doors and other places where these pests may enter premises

Crack-and-Crevise and Void Treatments Apply uniformly in small amounts in and around areas where insects may be crawling hiding or living The amount to be applied may vary depending on the severity of the problem and the site to be treated but should only be applied in areas no greater than 3 feet by 3 feet per room to void areas around and behind interior and exterior walls cabinets baseboards moldings pipe openings electrical outlets stairs window and door frames and appliances

Spot Treatment Only apply to as a spot treatment to areas no greater than 3 feet by 3 feet per room Limit spot treatments to wall or floor surfaces where pests have been seen or where pests are suspected of hiding Spot treatment may also be made to areas where any of the above pests hide or inhabit such as baseboards storage areas closets around water pipes doors and windows behind and under refrigerators cabinets sinks stoves and other equipment
