Also following the sentence beginning "Lightly work the material xxxxx," add the statement: "Use brush/comb to work material down to the skin."

- (h) The disposal statements proposed are overlabeled for a product intended for household use. Therefore, following your Storage statement add the following statements: "Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash."

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of accidental ingestion or massive contact with DIATECT PET POWDER, or as soon as any person shows symptoms of having been affected by DIATECT PET POWDER:

1. Remove the victim to a place where he/she will be safe from any further contact with the pesticide.
2. Cause the victim to lie down and keep quiet.
3. Call physician and inform him/her as to the name and formulation of DIATECT PET POWDER and to any first-aid given up to that time.
