

spoonfuls (1 oz.) per gallon water. Allow 60 days between oil sprays; limit to three applications per year.

**PALM TREES:** to control scale insects, mealy bugs & red spider mites: 3 tablespoonfuls (1½ oz.) per gallon water.

**AZALEAS, CAMELLIAS:** to control scale insects, red spider mites, mealy bugs, white fly larvae, lace bug larvae: 5 tablespoonfuls (2½ oz.) per gallon water.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:**

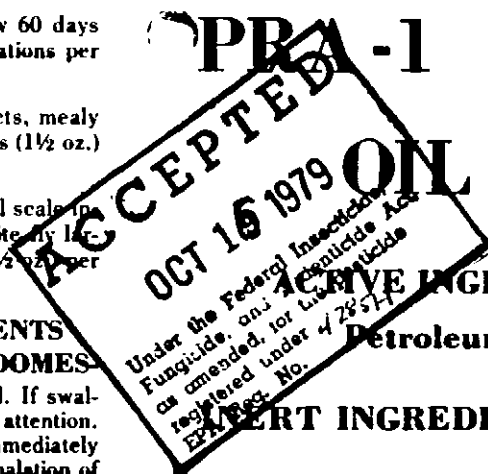

**USE FORCEFUL SPRAY: WET THOROUGHLY**

**HOUSE PLANTS:** Use as is to control scale and sooty mold fungus.

**AS A PLANT POLISH:** Use as is to brighten leaves of hardy house plants.

**FOR GROWING SEASON:** to control scale insects, red spider mites, mealy bugs, white fly larvae and fungus on pineapples, bananas, tomatoes, grapes, melons, citrus (oranges, lemons, grapefruits, tangerines, & limes), and fruit trees (apple, plum, apricot, mango, avocado, peach, pear & cherry), shade trees, evergreens, camellias, azaleas, & hardy shrubs: 5 tablespoonfuls (2½ oz.) per gallon water. (This application is also effective in the removal of sooty mold fungus through its control of white fly larvae.)

**FOR DORMANT USE:** to control scale insects, red spider mites & mealy bugs on dormant shrubs, evergreens, woody plants, bananas, fruit trees (apple, plum, apricot, mango, avocado, peach, pear & cherry), and shade trees: ½ pint (5½ oz.) per gallon water.

**GREENHOUSES:** to control scale insects, red spider mites, white fly larvae, mealy bugs on hardy shrubs, gardenias, camellias & azaleas: 2 table
