The revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) agrees with the label and is acceptable.

Deletion of the proposed alternate sources for detergent Iconol NP-9; Iconol OP-10; Surfonic N; - Triton N10; and Igepal CO630 from the CSF is acceptable.

Delete statement "(includes essential oil odor control agents)" from below the ingredient statement. If you wish to list inert ingredients then you must list them all by well-known common names or correct chemical names.

The revised report for Herpes Simplex virus is acceptable in support of label claims for this virus and has been made a part of the product file.

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label instructions. Prepare a fresh work solution daily or more frequently as required. Do not mix with other chemicals or products including anionic soaps and detergents.

As a disinfectant: Used as directed (2 oz. per gallon or 1 to 64) A-3 provides 390 ppm effective germicide action further enhanced by an organic chelating agent that inactivates metallic ions. A-3 rapidly destroys a broad range of GRAM-POSITIVE and GRAM-NEGATIVE ORGANISMS. It kills mold and mildew on contact on hard nonporous surfaces when used according to directions.

As a general disinfectant: Mix 2 oz. of A-3 with one gallon of water - hot or cold. Apply solution with mop, cloth, scrubber or sprayer to precleaned surface and allow to remain wet for 10 minutes.

As a one-step hospital disinfectant: For use on nonporous hard surfaces such as walls, tables, floors, bedframes, bathroom fixtures and other similar surfaces where pseudomonacidal action is desired dilute 3 oz./gal.
