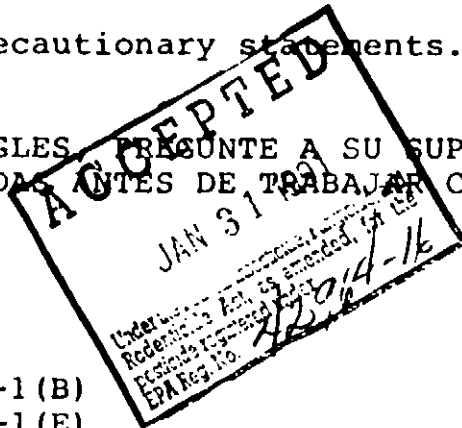

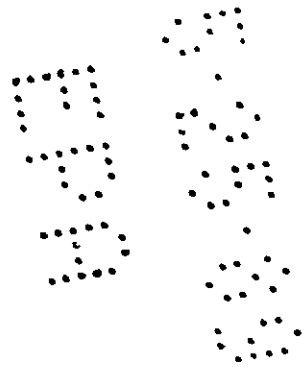

KILLS: Roaches, Earwigs, Grain Mites, Sowbugs, Spiders, Centipedes, and Ants.

CONTROLS: Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Use only in food processing plants when plant is not in operation. Foods should be covered or removed during treatment. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS LISTED ABOVE: Apply, undiluted, as a contact spray. Adjust pressure and nozzle to deliver a coarse wet spray. When possible, spray directly on roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes to reduce infestations. Spray areas to be treated thoroughly.

ANTS: When observed, spray directly. In addition, to control infestations, trails, nests and points of entry may be sprayed. Repeat if necessary.

FOR FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, and gnats, present on the surface of the refuse, will be killed when sprayed directly with a dilution of 1 part Aquinoc plus 1-1/2 parts water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store at ambient temperature. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not freeze.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
