The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

a) Revise the statement in the Caution section to read:

"All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed and cleaned before using. Do not apply when food processing is in operation. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

- b) Correct the spelling of "devises" to read "devices"
- c) Remove the statement "FOR USE IN MANUAL AND AUTOMATIC DISPENSING SYSTEMS. This statement has no directions for use.
- d) On page 2 add "INDOOR USE" FOR CRAWLING INSECTS LISTED BELOW" in the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section.

Three (3) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.
