Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1

### Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the "If Swallowed" section of the First Aid Statements to read:

**IF SWALLOWED**: Call a poison control center or doctor *immediately* for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

2. Delete the word "biodegradable" from the statement "Contains biodegradable detergents and is noncorrosive and nonabrasive." The Agency does not allow claims such as "biodegradable" which imply the safety of a pesticide or its

3. Revise the statement "...cleaning power with 1,000 ppm of quaternary germicide." to read "...cleaning power with 1,000 ppm quaternary disinfectant." This product must be effective against bacteria, fungi, and viruses to be considered a germicide.
