DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

1. For every 10,000 gallons of water, add 1/2 ounce of this product to the pool water. For example, for a 30,000 gallon pool, add 1 1/2 ounces of this product.

2. Add the product to the pool water in the following manner:

a. Turn the pool pump on and allow the water to circulate for 15 minutes.

b. Add the product to the pool water in a bucket and pour it into the pool.

c. Turn the pool pump on and allow the water to circulate for 15 minutes.

d. Repeat steps a, b, and c until the required amount of product has been added.

**DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE
WATER SYSTEMS**

1. Turn the water supply off to the system to be treated.

2. Add the product to the water in the following manner:

a. Turn the water supply on and allow the water to flow for 15 minutes.

b. Add the product to the water in a bucket and pour it into the water.

c. Turn the water supply on and allow the water to flow for 15 minutes.

d. Repeat steps a, b, and c until the required amount of product has been added.
