

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONTACT, SPACE AND RESIDUAL SPRAY: around premises of commercial, industrial, preschools, nurseries, day camps, seed houses, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, hospitals. In hospitals, patients should be removed from boxcars and ship cargo holds. Also for use in food. Do not use on electrical equipment or

SPACE SPRAY: FLYING INSECTS: To kill moths (millers): Apply as a space spray. Fill spray tank and nozzle. Point nozzle upward and attract these insects. Keep the spray nozzle a foot from the surface. Spray a fine mist at the dosage of one fluid ounce per 1,000 cubic feet for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room

CONTACT SPRAY - CRAWLING INSECTS: spiders, sowbugs (pillbugs), centipedes, millipedes, red flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, Mediterranean flour moths, shiny spiders bedbugs, etc. Apply as a contact spray. Fill spray tank with undiluted product. Adjust pressure and nozzle to deliver a coarse spray. Adjust nozzle to deliver a coarse spray. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, YELLOW JACKETS: Apply liberally into hiding and breeding places, especially in attics.

FIRE ANTS: Kills and reduces annoyance of fire ants. Spray patios, barbecue areas, driveways, entryways, around pools and other areas where the ants are present. Treatment will not kill the colonies but will reduce the annoyance of large areas of lawns.

CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, EARWIGS, SPIDERS: Apply as directed above for indoor use.
