CH ALGICIDE is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, water treated pools, whirlpools and hot baths. For maximum effectiveness pools containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using CH ALGICIDE.

For ponds having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 75 to 110 fluid ounces of CE ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 4½ to 5 fluid ounces of GP ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain ponds free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 13.6 to 27.5 milliliters of CP ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water are required at least once every 14 days after the initial treatment.

CP ALGICIDE is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools such as chlorine, bromine, acid and alkaline pH. CP ALGICIDE can be used with other algaecides and chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix CP ALGICIDE with chlorine or bromine products.

For ponds having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 75-115 fluid ounces of CP ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.

For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 41 7/8 fluid ounces of CP ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions 136 to 272 fluid ounces of CP ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

CP ALGICIDE is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat water effectively at both acid and alkaline pH. CP ALGICIDE reacts slowly with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine normally required. However, do not mix CP ALGICIDE with strong hydrochloric acid or chlorine products.
