DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in

In swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy algae growth, use PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 to using PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600

For pools having just visible algae growth add 1 fluid ounce of PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 for 10,000 gallon pools should be made every 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds with heavy algae growth require an initial dose of 1 fluid ounce of PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1.1 fluid ounces of PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 should be made every 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600

Use PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 in the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Only treat during the swimming season and add 10 fluid ounces of algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. If season pools have some visible algae growth, add 10 fluid ounces of algaecide per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform circulation of water and the pool be made for maximum effect. If necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times.

PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 is used to treat pools and spas and is effective against algae. PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 can be used with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine needed. However, do not mix PROSUPER ALGAECIDE 600 with other chlorine products.

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Label should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in a separate container. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty containers.
