DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pro-
duct in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING

Lightly soiled areas - surfaces to be cleaned
should be wiped or brushed with a solution
containing 1 ounce of TC 802 per gallon of wa-
ter. For severely soiled areas, see Heavy.

Heavy - soiled areas - floors or other hard sur-
face - wet a solution containing 2 ounces of
TC 802 per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned sur-
face with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, and other hard non-
porous surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants,
restaurants and other public areas mop or brush
with a fresh solution containing 1 ounce of
TC 802 per gallon of water so as to maintain
thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. All
soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned prior to dis-
infection (follow directions for cleaning). These
surfaces which may later come in contact with
food must be rinsed with clear water of drink-
ing quality. Do not reuse used solution.

To disinfect hard, nonporous surfaces in locker
rooms, shower walls, walkways around pools
and other areas against pathogenic fungi, mop
or brush with a fresh solution containing 1
ounce of TC 802 per gallon of water so as to
maintain thoroughly wetted surface for ten
minutes. This solution will destroy Trichophy-
ton interdigitale, a causative agent of athlete's
foot. All soiled surfaces must be pre-cleaned
prior to disinfection (follow directions for
cleaning). Do not reuse used solution.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other
hard, nonporous surfaces in hospitals and nurs-
ing homes, mop or brush with a fresh solution
containing 2 ounces of TC 802 per gallon of
water so as to maintain thoroughly wetted sur-
face for ten minutes. All soiled surfaces must
be pre-cleaned prior to disinfection (follow di-
rections for cleaning). Those surfaces that are
heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or so-
lids should be thoroughly scrubbed with a so-
lution containing 2 ounces of TC 802 per gallon
of water, and then rinsed with a fresh solution
containing 2 ounces of TC 802 per gallon of
water before disinfection. Do not reuse used
solution. This product has not been tested for
effectiveness against Mycobacterium tuberculo-
sis and must not be relied upon when tubercu-
lous activity is intended by the user.

DEODORIZATION

For deodorization of bathroom areas, gar-
bage pits, diaper pails, food storage areas, bas-
ement areas and other areas where odorous odors
may develop, remove all garbage, refuse, food
and animal. Pre-clean surfaces using pre-
brushed water where possible before deodoriz-
ing. To deodorize mop or brush surfaces
thoroughly with a solution containing 2 ounces
of TC 802 per gallon of water.
