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FOOD AREA APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage, mid enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, and syrups.) Serving arm (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) also would be considered a food area.

Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment capable of applying insecticide directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held.

Food/feed areas of food/feed areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after bottling or canning). In the home, coverall food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Includes areas for receiving considered food area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

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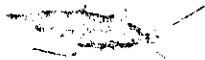

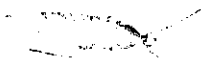

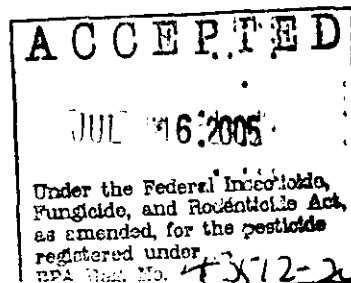
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply liberally, scattering under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs; into openings around (drains, water pipes and electrical conduits; and in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, cupboards, and closets Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chest of drawers, then scatter liberally in drawer wells.

Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
