DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. MXT-60 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness in decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth to using MXT-60.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of MXT 60. Remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of MXT-60 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of MXT-60 per 10,000 gallons of water after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains and algae growth require an initial dose of 1 MXT-60 per 1000 gallons of cleaned spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain. 1.1 fluid ounces of MXT-60 of water. Subsequent additions of 0.2 MXT-60 should be made for maintenance.

MXT-60 will be used during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools only treated during the swimming season and are treated with 10 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons. If during the swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 10 fluid ounces of MXT-60 per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. Repeat the treatment one or more times if necessary.

MXT-60 is compatible with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine available. However, do not mix MXT-60 with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container.
