Dear Ms. Davis:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following changes to your label:

a) Add the following two sentences to the Directions For Use:

"Do not use on pregnant dogs. Do not repeat application more than once a week."

2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks and household latex or rubber gloves when applying this product.
- ▶ Change clothing as soon as possible after use.
- ▶ Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As with any pesticide product, wash hands thoroughly immediately after handling and before eating, smoking or using the toilet.

Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust entire animal, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas. Rub or brush pet's hair to work down to the skin. Contact ticks with powder. Do not reapply product for one week. This product should not be applied by children. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 12 weeks of age.

For kennels and living quarters, using a shaker can or other dust applicator, dust bedding and floor at the rate of 1 ounce (28 gms) per 50 square feet of surface. Repeat as needed.

**STORAGE:** Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or moisture. Protect from temperatures above 100°F. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container; wrap container and discard in trash.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

**CAUTION: Humans:** Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid inhalation of dust or contact with skin. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. **Animals:** Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides or chemicals. However, flea and tick collars may be immediately replaced.

#### First Aid

If Swallowed: Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. **If In Eyes:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. **If On Skin:** Immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Wash clothing prior to reuse. **If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air. Contact a physician if warranted. **Note to Physicians and Veterinarians:** Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, only by injection, is antidotal. 2-PAM may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
