
The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Under the Directions for Use, the statements "Do not reapply product for one week" and "Repeat as needed" must be revised to read "Do not retreat within thirty days". The current retreatment directions conflict with the precautionary statements for animals. See PR Notice 96-6 for more information.
2. The heading STORAGE AND DISPOSAL must appear above the directions for use for storage and disposal.
3. Revise the Note to Physicians and Veterinarians to read as follows: "Carbaryl is a N-methyl carbamate that inhibits cholinesterase. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use 2-PAM (pyridene-2-aldoxime methiodide), opiates or cholinesterase inhibiting drugs. Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- User Safety Requirements**
- Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks and household latex or rubber gloves when applying this product.
 - Change clothing as soon as possible after use.
 - Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As with any pesticide product, wash hands thoroughly immediately after handling and before eating, smoking or using the toilet.

Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust entire animal, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas. Rub or brush pet's hair to work down to the skin. Contact ticks with powder. Do not reapply product for one week. Do not allow children to apply this product. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 12 weeks of age.

For kennels and living quarters, using a shaker can or other dust applicator, dust bedding and floor at the rate of 1 ounce (28 gms) per 50 square feet of surface. Repeat as needed.

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or moisture. Protect from temperatures above 100°F. **Disposal: If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency [or 1-800-CLEANUP] for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Note to Physicians and Veterinarians: Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, only by injection, is antidotal. 2-PAM may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.
