DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use only in a well ventilated area. Remove birds and cover aquariums before spraying. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. Do not repeat treatment for 2 to 3 days.

Dogs, Cats and Rabbits: Cover animal's eyes with hand and spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. The spray neck, body and legs. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired dogs, cats and rabbits rub hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffed hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. To control spinose ear ticks and ear mites, apply 10 drops to each ear to ensure product penetrates wax down to surrounding tissues

Puppies and Kittens: Spray only along back or on your fingertips and rub into coat.

Pet Sleeping Quarters: Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, floors, carpets, around baseboards, windows, door frames and wall cracks. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, lightly spray into the air. Put fresh bedding in animal's quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended.

Horses and Ponies: To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies apply to face, neck, legs, flanks, topline and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat treatment as needed.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame. **Disposal: If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency [or 1-800-CLEANUP] for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
