DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Directly on Birds to Control Bird Lice. Leave birds in cage. Remove food and water. Lightly spray with 3 or 4 pumps directly on birds from a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Avoid the bird's eyes and face. Repeat twice a week.

Use on Cage and Aviary Surfaces to Control Feather Mites. Remove bird(s)' food and water cups, etc. Thoroughly spray cage and aviary surfaces from a distance of at least one foot, using 5 to 6 pumps per cage. Thoroughly spray outside of the cage bottom as feather mites often live there.

Repeat treatment in aviary, cages and on birds twice a week. Clean bird cages in hot water weekly.

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or sunlight. Protect from freezing. **Disposal: If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency [or 1-800-CLEANUP] for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
