The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the referenced product in connection with the pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide **RED**, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable

NOTE This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156 140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on <u>non-refillable</u> containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10

Use Directly on Birds to Control Bird Lice Leave birds in cage Remove food and water Lightly spray with 3 or 4 pumps directly on birds from a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Avoid the bird's eyes and face. Repeat twice a week

Use on Cage and Aviary Surfaces to Control Feather Mites Remove bird(s) food and water cups etc Thoroughly spray cage and aviary surfaces from a distance of at least one foot using 5 to 6 pumps per cage Thoroughly spray outside of the cage bottom as feather mites often live there. Do not wet cages or aviary surfaces to the point of runoff or drip

Repeat treatment in aviary, cages and on birds twice a week Clean bird cages in hot water weekly

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal

Pesticide Storage Store in original container in a cool dry (preferably locked) place inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or sunlight Protect from freezing Pesticide/Container Disposal Non refillable container do not reuse or refill this container If empty Offer for recycling, if available, otherwise discard in trash If partly filled Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain
