The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

The alternate brand name R-7M Feather Care for Birds Scalex Mite & Lice Spray for Birds has been added to the product record.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. #### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

**Use Directly on Birds to Control Bird Lice.** Leave birds in cage. Remove food and water. Lightly spray with 3 or 4 pumps directly on birds from a distance of 12-18 inches. Avoid the bird's eyes and face. Repeat twice a week.

**Use on Cage and Aviary Surfaces to Control Feather Mites.** Remove bird(s)' food and water cups, etc. Thoroughly spray cage and aviary surfaces from a distance of at least 1 foot, using 5-6 pumps per cage. Thoroughly spray the outside of the cage bottom as feather mites often live there. Do not wet cages or aviary surfaces to the point of runoff or drip.

Repeat treatment in aviary, cages and on birds twice a week. Clean bird cages in hot water weekly.

#### Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or sunlight. Protect from freezing. Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Non-refillable container; do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Offer for recycling, if available, otherwise discard in trash. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
